- **B.** Briefing on the finalization of the Burton Hill Elementary School bus lane and crossing project.
 - Chief Reaves provided an updated and noted that there were a few outstanding items including adding crossbars to the cross walk, and minor signage adjustments. Staff will also review the brightness and color of the LED lights.
 - Chairwoman Aller requested this item be on the next meeting agenda.
- C. Review and discuss the Fiscal Year 20-21 street lighting project.
 - Chief Reaves reported on the public safety reasons to install street lighting at all intersections. He also outlined identified issues of existing lights being blocked by mature trees. He will proceed with adding lights that he has identified as a public safety need; those are along Seymour Lane and at each traffic intersection. In addition, he will continue to work with residents who desire additional lighting in their neighborhood.

- **D.** Discuss and take action recommending the city council consider a Green Space, Parks and Trails Crime Prevention Plan.
 - No action was taken, as Chief Reaves was directed to meet with Mr. Hughes, Ms. Schmitz and the Fairways HOA, to determine their desired hours of operations for the portion of the trail in close proximity to their property.
