Candidate Introductions

Tuesday, April 9th, at 12:30 PM at the monthly community luncheon in the Community Room. The Chief of Police will emcee and the City Secretary will serve as moderator. Candidates will be given the opportunity to introduce themselves and address the audience. Citizens will not be given the opportunity to ask questions at this event.

Candidate Forum

Candidate Forum held on Tuesday, April 16th, at 6:30 PM, in the Council Chamber. The City Secretary will act as emcee and moderator. A Question Submission Form will be mailed to each household, posted on the city website & emailed via the city's subscription service. Westworth Village citizens can use this form to submit questions in advance that they would like posed to the candidates. The Question Submission Forms are due to the City Secretary's Office no later than 5 PM on March 29th. Submitted questions will be categorized, compiled, and asked of each candidate. Citizens are encouraged to attend and listen to the candidate answers at the forum. However, during the forum questions will not be taken from the floor; therefore, it is important that questions are submitted in advance. Annual Spring Clean-Up

We cannot accept paints, tires, oil, insecticides, items that are harmful to the environment, refrigerators, air conditioners, any Freon bearing items, batteries, or other hazardous material.

If you need to dispose of hazardous waste at any time, please visit our Water Department to receive a voucher to Fort Worth's Environmental Collection Center. Vouchers cost \$50 and you must bring your driver's license or current water bill with you for proof of residency.

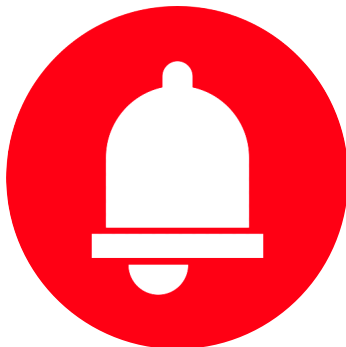
