Sewer Rate Averaging

REMINDER: On this month's bill, you will likely notice a change to your sewer rate. This new rate will remain in effect for one year. Here are some answers to some FAQs we get each year when we run this process:

- **Why do we need to do sewer averaging?**
- This process is in line with industry standards. Only incoming water can be metered by the system, so the city must rely on averaging your water consumption from the December—February billing cycles in order to assess sewer (outgoing water) fees.
- **Why is sewer charged at a higher rate than water?**
- Due to the cost associated with processing waste water to make it clean
- **Why are the winter months used for the averaging process?**
- Because irrigation systems are least in use, meaning the incoming metering during this time is the most accurate estimation of water that is actually being returned to the sewer system.
- **What if I moved in during the averaging period? Do you use the prior resident's usage in my average?**
- No. Accounts started during the averaging period will retain the calculated citywide average that was applied to their account when it was opened. Any new account opened after the averaging period will have the new city-wide average applied to their account.

Street Sweeping

Street sweeping starts at 9AM as follows:

- 02/17/25 – odd side of city street
- 02/18/25 – trash pick up day, no street sweeping
- 02/19/25 – even side of city streets
- 02/20/25 – alleyway
