ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 06, 2017, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCIL MEMBER PLACES 1, 5, AND THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE, TEXAS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Westworth Village, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Tarrant County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Westworth Village, Texas (the "City"), caused to be published in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, notice of the election held May 6, 2017, for the election of council member places 1, 5 and Mayor of the City; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate authority of the City caused to be posted and published, in accordance with applicable laws, notice of said election; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held on May 6, 2017, in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been certified and returned by the proper judge and clerks thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the returns of said election held May 6, 2017, and pursuant to state law, the Council shall canvass and declare the official results; and

WHEREAS, the election returns, duly and legally made, showed that there were cast at said election a total of 191 valid and legal votes, of which 52 were cast early, and 139 were cast on election day; and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Each and every one of the recitals, findings, and determinations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby repeated and incorporated herein as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2: It is further found and determined that the results of the election as canvassed and tabulated, as referenced in the preamble to this Ordinance, reflect the expressed desires of the residents, qualified electors of the City, and that the above canvass is hereby approved.


SECTION 3: The duly elected members of the City Council of the City of Westworth Village, Texas, elected on May 6, 2017, council member places 1,5 and Mayor, subject to the taking of the oaths as provided by the laws of the State of Texas, are as follows:

Council Member, Place 1	Carlos Zavala
Council Member, Place 5	Dan Novak
Mayor	Michael R. Coleman



SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its final passage and approval, and it is so ordained.


