Koldin Lane is a residential street with a 20 MPH speed limit which is contrary to the 30 MPH speed limit established by the Texas State Statues for residential speed limits in a General Law city.

- In February of 2016, the speed humps were removed from Koldin Lane due to complaints by a resident of vehicles driving in to yards to avoid the speed bumps.
- Since the removal of the speed humps, there have been several complaints of speeding motorists on Koldin Lane




- The traffic study has been conducted at the 100 block of Koldin Lane.

- The trailer remained in place for two weeks to monitor the traffic patterns during the week as compared to the weekend.





## Koldin Lane Traffic Findings

- 16, 474 vehicles traveled on Koldin Lane during the survey period
- 8,992 vehicles traveling on Koldin Lane were at 20 MPH or below.
- 5, 085 vehicles were traveling between 20 and 25 MPH
- 1,869 vehicles were traveling between 26 MPH and 30 MPH
- Upon evaluating the data from the study, we were able to determine there were 548 out of 16,474 vehicles using Koldin Lane traveling over 30 MPH.



#### Koldin Lane Traffic Recommendations

- The goal of the Westworth Village Police Department in this study
  was to educate the residents of Koldin Lane as well as the drivers in
  the actual speeds of cars upon the roadway through the use of the
  visual display of speed on the SMART trailer.
- Upon conducting a compliance and risk analysis of Koldin Lane, we determined the majority of vehicles utilizing Koldin Lane would be within compliance of the speed limit if it was posted at 30 MPH.
- The traffic study determined the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile for Koldin Lane to be **22.79 MPH** in a posted **20 MPH** speed zone.
- Based upon the information gathered from this survey, my recommendation is the speed limit on Koldin Lane needs to be more closely aligned with the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile.
