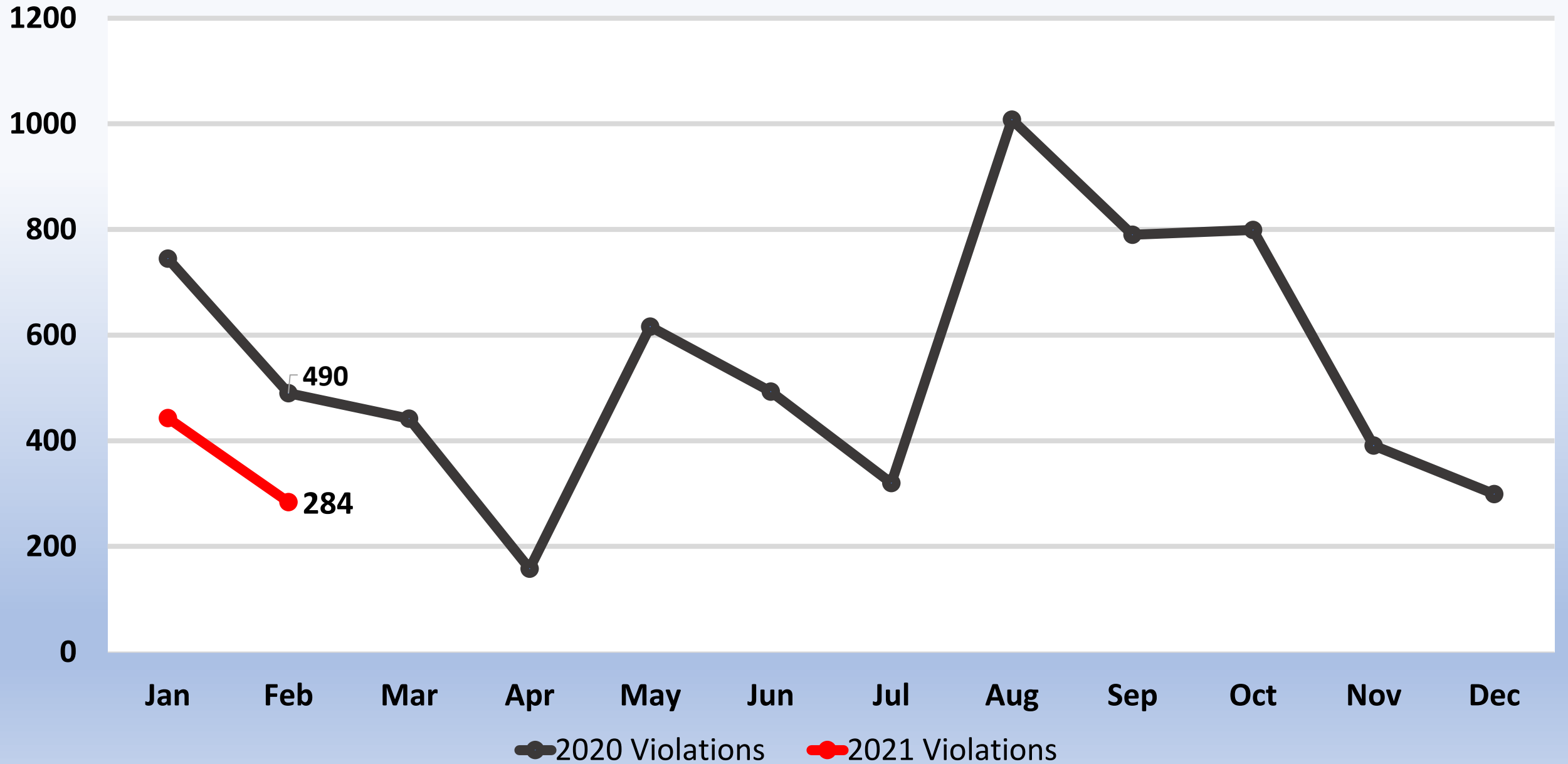

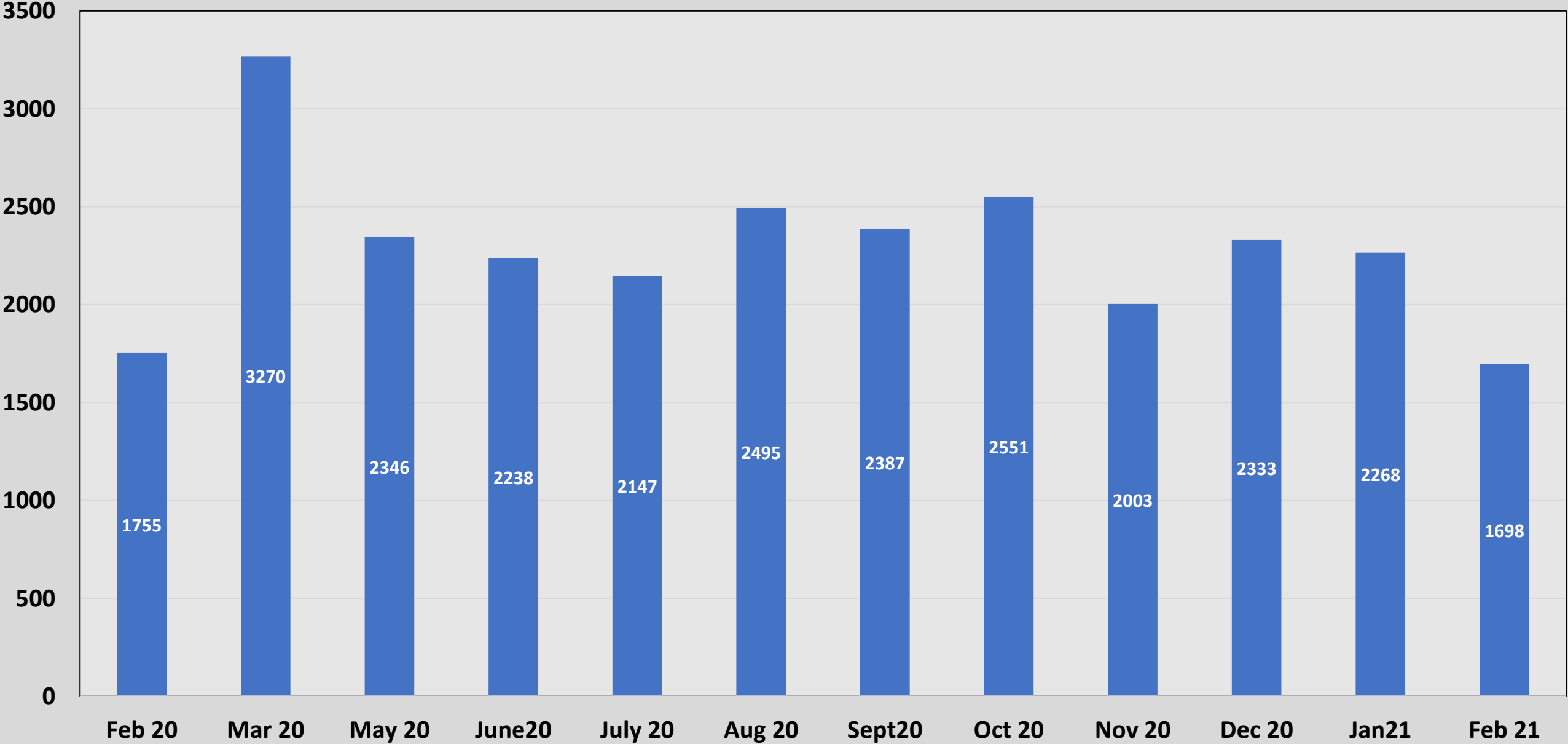

# Number of Violations per Month



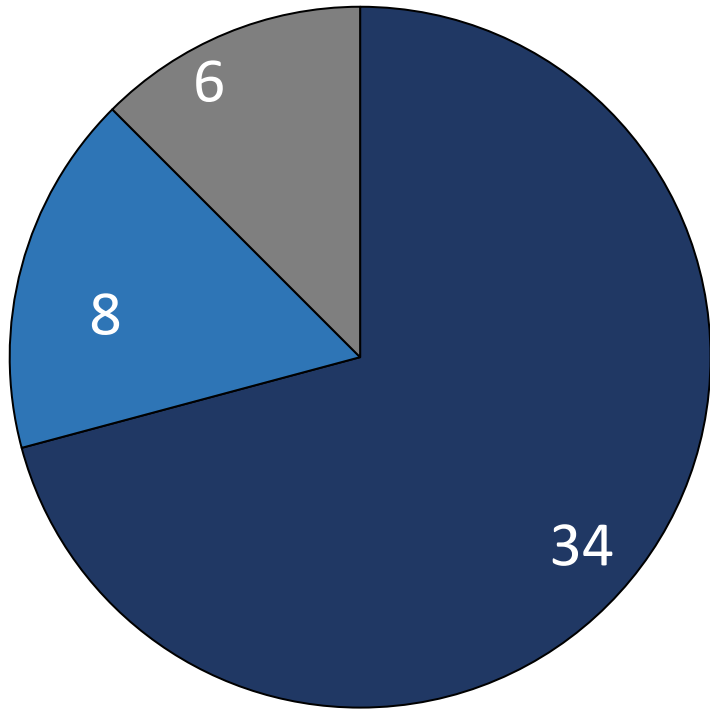


# Total Calls for Service



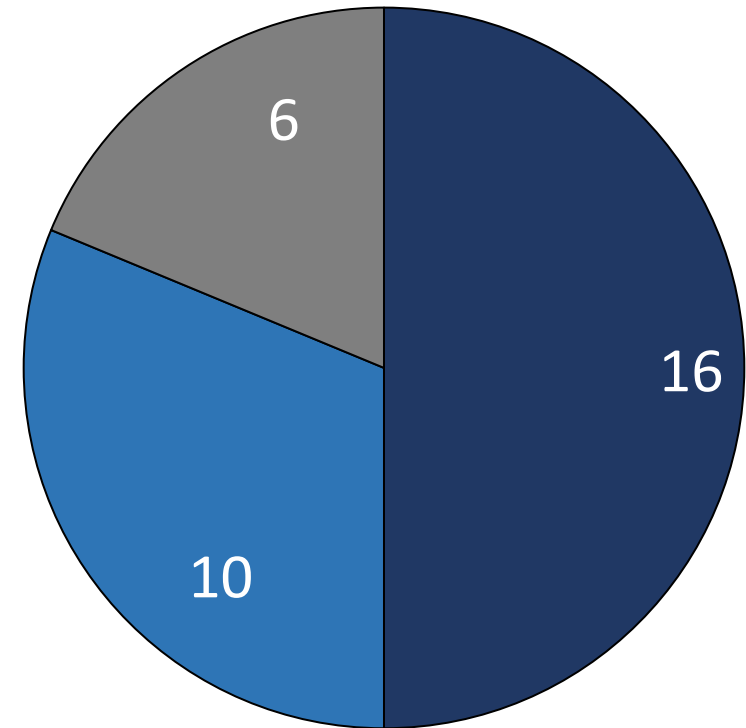
# Charges Resulting From Arrests Summary

**FEBRUARY Year to Date 2020**



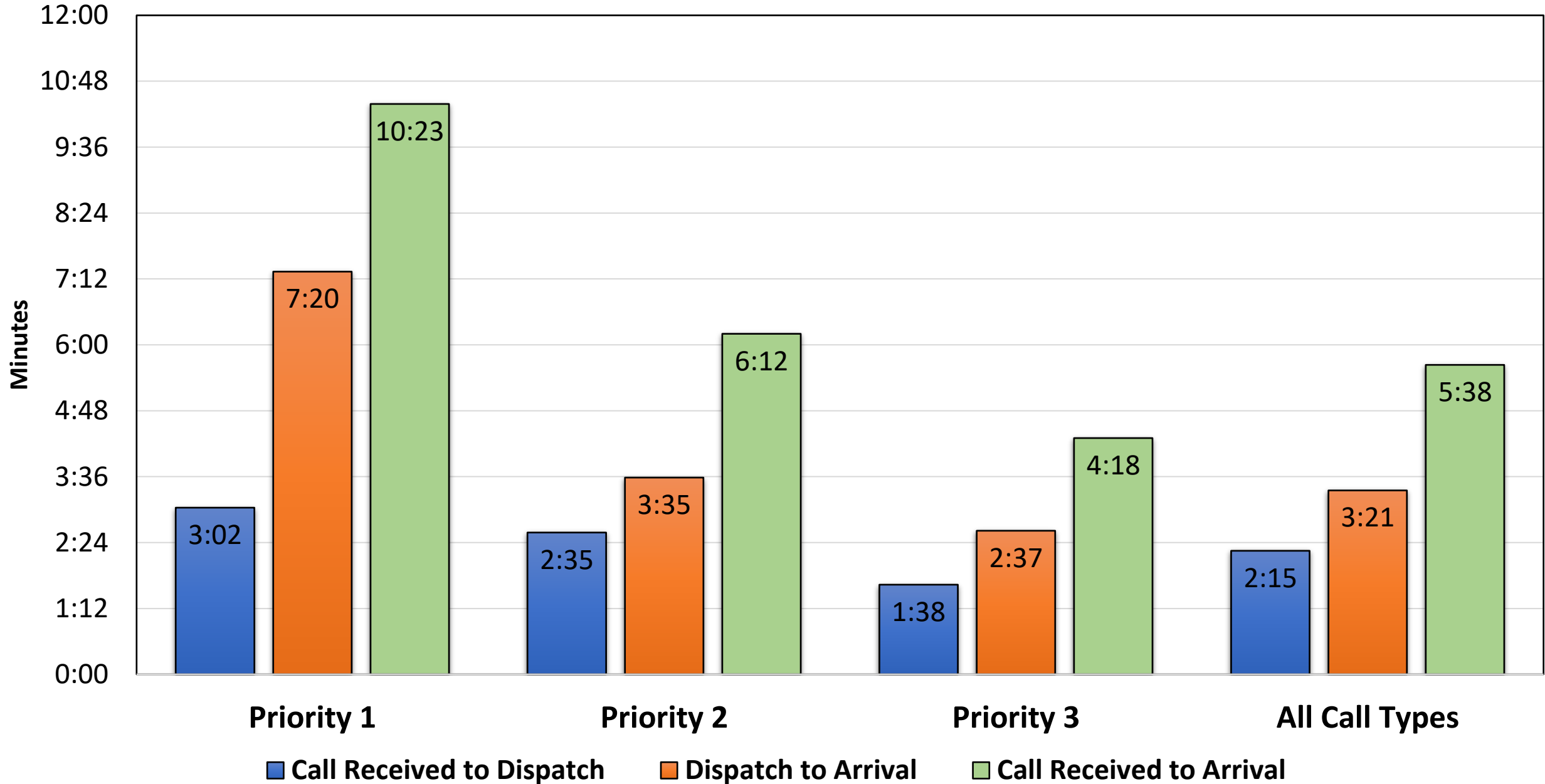

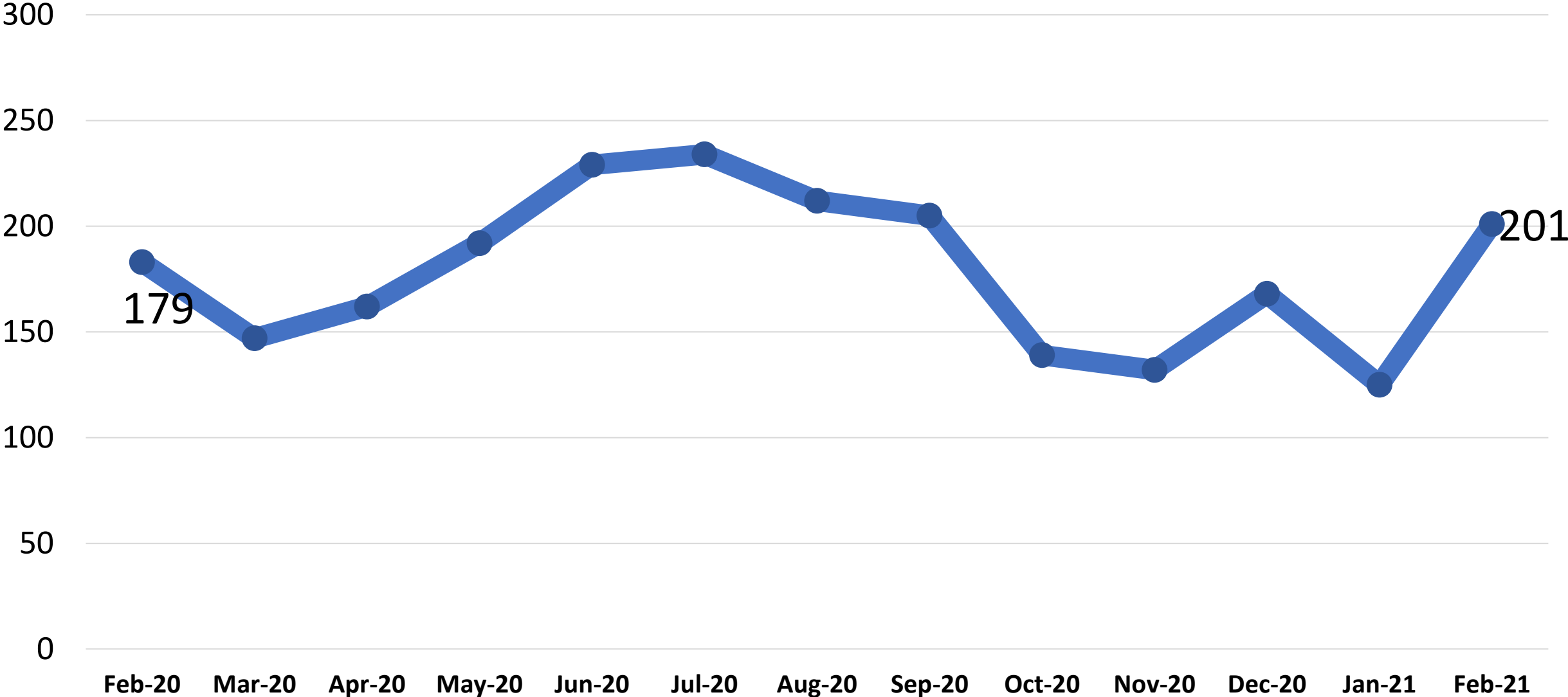
# FEBRUARY 2021 Response Times



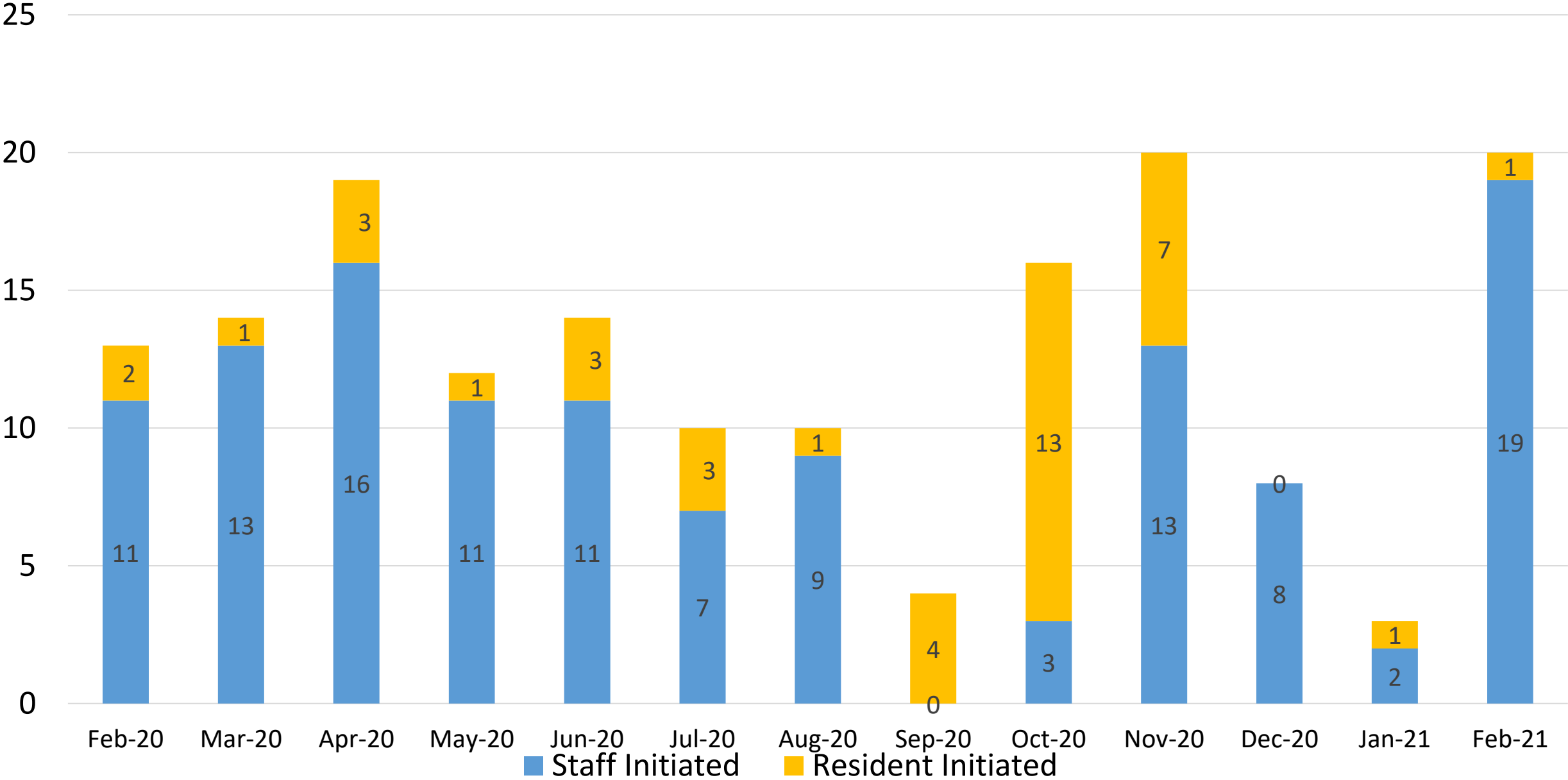
