I. CALLED TO ORDER at 5:45pm, by Chairman Encke.

- II. Approval of Minutes from CCPD meeting on December 13, 2011.
 - **MOTION** to approve minutes by Melva Campbell. **SECOND** by Paul Hughes. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 Ayes and 0 Nays.
- III. Review Financials: F-YTD Disbursements & Variance Reports.
 - City Administrator, Roger Unger, presented the fiscal year-to-date disbursements; variance report; and discussed the actual FY 10-11 financials, which include audit adjustments, the current FY 11-12 budget, as well as the preliminary FY 11-12 budget. Sales tax is tracking as expected. Kwik Kar is expected to generate a noticeable amount of sales tax revenue. Dunkin Donuts is anticipated to be operating by August. Other retailers are showing interest in the Shoppes at Hawks Creek center. Jett Express does not generate sales tax revenue; however it does provide revenue through the sale of water.
 - Roger stated that the budget line for a new Municipal Complex sign will likely be delayed until a future budget year. Chief Reim stated that when project requirements change so does the funding.

- IV. Review and take action with respect to FY10-11 Audit.
 - Roger Unger stated that the audit came out very clean, with CCPD taking in \$258 more in revenue than what was spent. Roger discussed internal process changes as suggested by the auditors.
 - **MOTION** to accept the FY 2010-2011 Audit by Jill Patton. **SECOND** by Paul Hughes. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 Ayes and 0 Nays.
- V. Discuss and take action with respect to **FY11-12 Budget**.
 - Discussed with item III.
- VI. Discuss preliminary FY12-13 Budget.
 - Chief Reim made a presentation on funding needs with respect to staffing, training, protective gear, police vehicles, and technology enhancements.
