Action Items:

- I. Approval of Minutes from P&Z meeting on March 12, 2013.
 - MOTION made by Margaret Worthington. SECOND by Jeannette Jones. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 Ayes and 0 Nays.
- II. Discuss and take action with respect to the use of alternative exterior materials for property at 6150 Westworth Blvd. This request is made per Ordinance 14.4.27(F).
 - City Administrator Roger Unger addressed the Commission describing the nature of the request by the homeowner to use standing-seam metal with baked-on enamel as siding for a garage and outbuilding to be used as an artist studio. The studio is for personal enjoyment and not a business. Current zoning of property is 'large lot residential'.
 - Ordinance 14.4.27(F) allows for consideration of alternative materials other than wood or masonry.
 Roger presented a sample of the material to the Commission. He stated while the material in question is mostly used for metal roofs, he believes it is not inferior to use as siding. Roger recommended approval.

- The written request, as stipulated in the ordinance, takes form in the architect's plans and drawings submitted to the City. Ryan Studdard assured the Commission that this consideration is in line with the City's newly approved Vision Plan.
- MOTION made by Margaret Worthington to accept and make recommendation to Council to approve the use of alternative exterior materials for the property at 6150 Westworth Blvd, specifically the standing-seam metal with baked on enamel, as presented. SECOND by Jim Evans. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 Ayes and 0 Nays.
