## **Action Items:**

- I. Approval of the Minutes from the WRA Meeting on October 9, 2012.
  - MOTION made by Nick Encke. SECOND by Melva Campbell. Motion passed unanimously, by a vote of 6 Ayes and 0 Nays.

# П. Discuss and take action to authorize and expend funds to contract with Freese & Nichols for a Parks

- Robert McGee and Cody Richardson from Freese & Nichols made a presentation describing the type of data that would be collected in a Parks Study and how that data could be used. A citywide survey is another tool to gather community needs and interests. Mr Richardson described grant opportunities from the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department.
- City Administrator Roger Unger stated that this parks discussion is being brought to the WRA Board (as opposed to Council) since it is an appropriate use of WRA funds as an EDC-B Corporation under the Texas Local Government Code [TLGC 505.001]. Previously the WRA has participated as a strictly redevelopment authority, however, as the community's needs change, the WRA has the opportunity to be a more complete resource.
- Discussion continued with Q&A from the Board to F&N and Roger. President Jones thanked Mr McGee and Mr Richardson for their presentation. The Board supports the idea of a Parks Study and possible plan implementation. This is an opportunity to tie into the TRWD Trail System, including Airfield Falls.
- President Jones instructed Roger to contact at least one other firm to receive a presentation of available study services. Roger stated if/when a firm is selected the Board will need to declare this a 'project'. The Board agreed to allow Roger to work with Mike Coleman to develop a community survey to assess the needs and wants of the residents.
