CALLED TO ORDER at 5:00 pm by Chairperson Melva Campbell.

Action Items:

- I. Discuss and take action to elect a Chair and Recording Secretary.
 - MOTION made by Jeannette Jones to re-appoint Melva Campbell to Chair and Darla Thornton to Secretary. SECOND by Mile Lewis. Motion passed by a vote of 6 Ayes and 0 Nays [Margaret Worthington had not yet arrived.]
- II. Approval of Minutes from P&Z meeting on May 14, 2013.
 - MOTION made by Mike Lewis to approve the minutes. SECOND by Jeannette Jones. Motion passed by a vote of 6 Ayes and 0 Nays [Margaret Worthington had not yet arrived.]

- III. Discuss and/or take action with respect to David Weekley potential rezoning request for a residential subdivision on nine (9) acres of commercial property.
 - Mr Larry Jackson, Land Acquisition Manager for David Weekley Homes, addressed the Commission, describing the community concept and answering questions. Mrs Rachel Wiggins, NAS JRB Community Liaison Officer, discussed military concerns, specifically noise attenuation and local residential density. Roger Unger discussed drainage and retention ponds, as well as roadway and easements.
 - Mr Jackson will work on City and Base recommendations and bring an updated design back to the Commission for review. No action was taken.
- IV. Discuss and/or take action with respect to Joe Howell's request for rezoning from Office to Office with Planned Development (PD) Overlay (for a Wellness Institute).
 - Mr Joe Howell, property owner, explained his concept plan and presented the preliminary site plan (Item V). Mr Glenn Griggs represented the architectural firm working on the design. Dr John Duncan discussed operations at other wellness locations. Q&A continued with full participation of Commission members and Roger Unger.
 - MOTION was made by Mike Lewis to move forward with the necessary steps to rezone the property. SECOND made by Margaret Worthington. Motion passed unanimously, by a vote of 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. [Required postings for Public Hearings of the P&Z and City Council will be handled by the City Secretary. Mr Howell will provide updated plans to the City Administrator and Commission Chair by the end of the month.]
- V. Discuss and/or take action with respect to PD preliminary site plan review for A319 Tract 4L of the Cornelius Connelly Survey.
 - This item discussed in conjunction with Item IV. No separate action taken on the site plan.
- VI. Next meeting date will be determined by publication and notice requirements for rezoning.
