CALLED TO ORDER at 6:45pm by Mayor Yeager.

OPEN PUBLIC HEARING #1 at 6:45pm.

Public Hearing to review Variance Request from Integrity Homes (Mr Lindsay Stites) to build within the two front setbacks (side yard of corner lot is second setback) of Lot 1, Block 1 of the Westworth Park Addition, addressed as 103 Monterra Circle.

- City Administrator Roger Unger and Building Inspector Ryan Studdard have reviewed the request and do not believe there would a significant impact on the neighbors. Roger recommended approval.
- No public comments received.

OPEN PUBLIC HEARING #2 at 6:56pm.

Public Hearing to review Variance Request from Mr Buddy Hudgins to build an in-ground pool within the rear setback line of Lot 14R, Block 2 of the Fairways at Westworth, addressed as 6601 Fairway Drive.

- Roger stated the pool will extend outside the property line onto the Westworth Park Homeowners
 Association property. The HOA covenants allow the encroachment and have approved the building
 plan. Granting the variance will exceed the setback requirement. Roger, Ryan, and Director of
 Community Development David Curwen recommend approval.
- No public comments received.

OPEN PUBLIC HEARING #3 at 6:58pm.

Public Hearing to review Variance Request from Mr Britton Pavlic to build on a lot that does not meet the minimum size requirements and reduce the front set back to 20' (currently 25') and rear setback to 10' (currently 15') on Lot 23, Block 14 of Westover Acres, addressed as 5852 Aton Ave.

- Roger explained without the variance the lot would be unusable. The building plan meets the new
 construction standards, including 80% brick and two-car garage. This construction will set the tone for
 future re-construction within the City.
- Resident JoAnn Rowls stated her concern over the front of the property not being uniform and "sticking out" beyond neighboring homes.

 - MOTION made by Nick Encke to grant the variance request to extend the setback of 6601 Fairway Drive as presented. SECOND by Jill Patton. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 Ayes and 0 Nays.

- 4. Discuss and take action with respect to the Variance Request from Mr Britton Pavlic for property addressed as 5852 Aton Ave.
 - MOTION made by Steve Beckman to grant the variance request to extend setbacks of 5852 Aton Ave as presented. SECOND by Jill Patton. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 Ayes and 0 Nays.
